MERKINCH AND SOUTH KESSOCK ENVIRONMENTAL WEEK



The first Environmental Week to be staged in Merkinch and South Kessock, Inverness, has been voted a big success in the communities.

A number of activities were organised for local adults and children to make environmental improvements to their area and to identify further projects that will make a difference to locals and visitors.

The focal point of Environmental Week was the construction of a stone feature at the gateway to the popular viewpoint at Carnarc Point, as part of a training scheme run by the British Trust for Conservation Volunteers.
