

NOTICE OF INTENTION (TO BE ADVERTISED 5th NOV 07)

THE HIGHLAND COUNCIL (TEMPORARY TRAFFIC RESTRICTIONS DURING INSTALLATION OF NEW WATER MAIN AND CITY CENTRE STREETScape WORKS, INVERNESS) ORDER 2007

NOTICE is hereby given that the Highland Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Sections 14 (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, hereby propose to make an Order:-

The reason for making the order is to enable temporary traffic restrictions to be put in place, required during the installation of a new water main and City Centre streetscape works on Union Street, Church Street and Queensgate, Inverness.

When the Order comes into effect the following temporary restrictions will come into force:

- (1) Temporary prohibition of vehicles (except for emergency vehicles, disabled vehicles, pedal cycles, motor cycles and vehicles making deliveries or requiring access to premises) on Union Street, Inverness.
- (2) Temporary prohibition of vehicles (except for emergency vehicles, disabled vehicles, pedal cycles, motor cycles and vehicles making deliveries or requiring access to premises) on that length of Church Street, Inverness, between its junction with Union Street and its junction with Queensgate.
- (3) Temporary prohibition of vehicles (except for buses, emergency vehicles, disabled vehicles, pedal cycles, motor cycles, vehicles making deliveries or requiring access to premises, taxis or hackney carriages bearing approved taxi markings while actively plying for hire) on Queensgate, Inverness.
- (4) Temporary prohibition of vehicles (except for buses, emergency vehicles, disabled vehicles, pedal cycles, motor cycles and vehicles making deliveries or requiring access to premises) on that length of Church Street, Inverness, between its junction with Friars Lane and its junction with Queensgate.
- (5) Temporary prohibition of right-hand turn from Academy Street, Inverness, into Union Street (except for emergency vehicles, disabled vehicles, pedal cycles, motor cycles and vehicles making deliveries or requiring access to premises).
- (6) Temporary prohibition of left-hand turn from Academy Street, Inverness, into Union Street (except for emergency vehicles, disabled vehicles, pedal cycles, motor cycles and vehicles making deliveries or requiring access to premises).
- (7) Temporary prohibition of right-hand turn from Friars Lane, Inverness, into Church Street (except for buses, emergency vehicles, disabled vehicles, pedal cycles, motor cycles and vehicles making deliveries or requiring access to premises).

- (8) Temporary prohibition of left-hand turn from Friars Lane, Inverness, into Church Street (except for buses, emergency vehicles, disabled vehicles, pedal cycles, motor cycles and vehicles making deliveries or requiring access to premises).
- (9) The parking of vehicles for the purpose of making deliveries, disabled parking and for collection and discharge of passengers from a service bus or taxi or Hackney carriage bearing approved taxi markings, while actively plying for hire, will only be permitted in bays indicated by start and end signage.

When the Order comes into effect the above temporary restrictions will come into effect on Monday 12 November 2007 and will remain in force for a period of up to 33 weeks.
